

TLC Wireless Microphone Kit Quick Setup Guide (Optional accessory to the Video Recording Kit)



Equipment List:

- Wireless Receiver
- Receiver Power Adapter
- Wireless Transmitter
- Lapel Microphone (Connected to Transmitter)
- XLR to 3.5mm Audio Cable
- Power Strip
- Carrying Case

Additional Needs:

- 9-Volt Battery

Basic Setup:

1. Remove the **Wireless Receiver** and aim **Antennas** upward.
2. Connect the **Audio Cable**'s large end to the back of the **Wireless Receiver** and make sure the nearby switch is set to **Mic**. The small end is for the camera's MIC port.
3. Connect the **Receiver Power Adapter** to the back of the **Wireless Receiver**, then plug into a power outlet.
4. Connect the **Lapel Microphone** to the top of the **Wireless Transmitter**, then insert a 9-volt battery into the front of the **Wireless Transmitter**.

Basic Usage:

5. Press the POWER button on the front of the **Wireless Receiver**. Its display should light up.
6. Confirm that the **Wireless Receiver** display shows the same Channel and Group as labeled.
7. To turn on the **Wireless Transmitter**, flip the power switch on the top to ON. The red battery-low light should flash once. Clip the lapel mic to your clothing about 8" down from your mouth.
8. Once both are on, test the microphone to ensure sound is coming through by talking and watching the display of the **Wireless Receiver**.
9. Once connected **test** the audio and adjust the gain on the **Wireless Receiver** until the desired loudness is reached.
